


WITHDRAWING FROM THE TERM:

NDS students will be able to withdraw themselves from the current term through Student Self Service and do not need to submit a withdrawal form. This self service withdrawal is available only to NDS students for the current term and will only be available until the last day to drop/withdraw.

Withdrawing after the start of the semester will result in dropping ALL of your enrolled classes. You will not be able to enroll in different classes for this term.
